RELEASE WAIVER (Please Read Carefully)

I have applied to participate in the Self Defense for Women Program offered by the Charlotte County Sheriff's Department, Charlotte County Board of County Commissioners (BCC) and instructed by Shuman's ATA Black Belt Academy.

I personally give the Instructors from Shuman's ATA Black Belt Academy permission to instruct me in these techniques and do not hold the Instructors, Shuman's Taekwondo, the American Taekwondo Association, personnel of the Charlotte County Sheriff's Office, the Charlotte County Sheriff's Office, the Charlotte County BCC, and Charlotte County Community Services Department liable for anything that might happen to me as a result of these classes.

I understand that by registering in this program I am subjecting myself to possible injury as I am voluntarily engaging in an active physical class. Before signing the application to register, I was given the opportunity to ask any questions. I have chosen not to ask questions or have had all of my questions answered to my satisfaction. By enrolling, I understand it is my responsibility to learn and understand all safety procedures and rules related to involvement in self defense seminars provided by Shuman's ATA Black Belt Academy.

As part of the agreement, in allowing me to participate in this program, I agree that the American Taekwondo Association (including it's officers, employees, agents, tournament organizers, and any other students); the Charlotte County Sheriff's Office (including it's deputies, employees, agents, and organizers); and Charlotte County BCC Community Services Department (including its elected officials, employees, agents, and organizers) will not be responsible for my safety nor do any of the parties assume any responsibility as a guardian or fiduciary.
